### European Employee Agri-Tech-Networking Project: Enhancing information and consultation at corporate and branch level in the European agricultural engineering industry

Against the background of accelerated internationalisation and globalisation of markets, corporate strategies and value chains in the agricultural engineering industry in Europe and in order to defend and strengthen employee participation, high labour standards and trade union membership in this industry which is employing around 170,000 people throughout the EU-27, the IG Metall together with representatives of the works council network agricultural engineering and metalworkers unions in Austria, the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland and Spain have initiated the European Employee Agri-Tech-Networking Project.

It is important to see the European Dimension of the project which is also reflected in the active participation of the EMF in project activities: At its congress in Lisbon in July 2007 the EMF decided to establish a Sector Committee on mechanical engineering and to develop a sub-committee structure including the agricultural machinery sector (along with other sectors like lifts/elevators, machine tools, textile machinery etc.). Our networking project is regarded in this context as having a model-like character.

Employment: In 2006, the total number of employees in the agricultural engineering industry of the Czech Republic was 9,400. The employment figures have demonstrated a significant decline of nearly 50% throughout the last years. In comparison, 11,200 people were employed in the industry in 2000. The total number of employees was under 8,400. Employment in the agricultural engineering industry is 1,3 % of the Czech Republic's total workforce.
